# Why Early Childhood is Important

Attachment to Jesus and the Church

- Many adults in the US have little attachment to their faith. (53% of US adults have left the faith of their childhood at some point; 9% leave and return)
- Is there a "God Gene"?
- The development of attachment

## Six Steps to Success -

## #1: Focus on Jesus and the Church

- Pope Francis: "In catechesis too, we have rediscovered the fundamental role of the first announcement or kerygma, which needs to be the center of all evangelizing activity and all efforts at Church renewal." (*The Joy of the Gospel*, 164).
- "The definitive aim of catechesis is to put people not only in touch, but also in communion and intimacy, with Jesus Christ". (*GDC*, 236).
- "Catechesis initiates them in knowledge of faith and apprenticeship in the Christian life." (*GDC*, 56).

#2: Use Active Learning Approaches, Including Music and Child Directed Activities

- Young children are concrete learners.
- The importance of hands-on learning
- Our Faith has a rich history of multisensory catechesis and worship.

# Six Tasks of Catechesis (GDC, NDC)

- Promoting knowledge of the faith
- Liturgical education
- Moral Formation
- Teaching to pray
- · Education for community life
- Missionary initiation

Knowledge of the Faith – interactive stories, object lessons, drama, music

#### **Trinity Song**

Liturgical Education (hands-on sacramental education through props and role play, vessels and vestments classroom altar).

SONG: Parts of the Mass

#### Vs.1

First is the Liturgy of the Word, of the Word, of the Word. And in the Liturgy of the Word, God speaks to us in Scripture.

#### Vs.2

The Liturgy of the Eucharist, Eucharist, Eucharist, The Liturgy of the Eucharist is our family meal.

#### Moral Formation

- Group rules/guidelines
  - o Clear (again, know the developmental level)
  - Concise
  - Positively phrased
  - Posted
  - Assertively stated
  - o Backed up by action
- Use of Everyday situations

#### Teaching to Pray

- Prayer pillowcases
- Group prayer in sacred space
- Rosary Readiness chaplets
- Music and movement

#### Positive effects of ritual

- Sense of security
- Bonding with others
- Behavioral expectations/ease of transition

#4: Plan Ahead

# Arrange the space to be

- o Inviting
- o Interesting, but not cluttered
- o Functional

#### Be Proactive

- o Forbidden objects put away
- Activity supplies ready
- Participant proximity to teacher and others

# #5: Involve Families

- Communicate with families
- Help them encounter Christ in family life
- o Provide information about how children this age understand this concept
- o Recommend prayers and simple activities families can use

#### #6: Be Joyful

- "A Christian is never bored or sad. Rather, the one who loves Christ is full of joy and radiates joy" —Pope Francis (via Twitter on 6/30/2013)
- o Joy is the natural disposition of the young child
- o They need to know that the Church is a happy and welcoming place.
